



# ASC Membership Application:

In order to complete your membership application please do the following:

1. Fill out this membership form
2. Read and sign the included *Rules of the Alaska Sailing Club*
3. Read and sign the included *Release of Liability Agreement*. You will need one completed copy of this agreement for each person covered by your membership.

Membership is on an annual basis, subject to the payment of annual dues. Annual dues are payable on or before April 15th of each year. By applying for membership, each member agrees to abide by the Rules of The Alaska Sailing Club included in this membership packet. Additionally, each application must be accompanied by a signed *Release of Liability Agreement* for each member.

## Membership Types

There are four types of memberships at the Alaska Sailing Club:

1. *Family Memberships* are intended to include "a family group living under one roof". Adult children (25 and over) are encouraged to purchase their own membership if they intend to use the club independently. Adult children (and any other family members living outside the house) are of course always welcome as guests assuming they have a sponsoring member present. The cost of a Family Membership is \$400.
2. *Single Memberships* are full memberships at the Alaska Sailing Club intended to cover one adult aged 18 or over. The cost of a Single Membership is \$300.
3. *Junior Memberships* are available only to individuals under age of 25. The cost of a Junior Membership is \$75.
4. *Associate Memberships* are available only to non-active members who do not utilize club facilities but wish to maintain an association with the Alaska Sailing Club. The cost of an Associate Membership is \$25.

## **Membership Fees**

The fees associated with an Alaska Sailing Club membership are as follows:

1. There are eight available moorings available in the Alaska Sailing Club harbor. The annual fee for use of a mooring is \$100, and a waiting list for mooring is maintained by the Harbormaster.
2. There are a number of available camper or RV spaces at the ASC where you may leave your trailer parked year-round. The annual fee for use of one of these spaces is \$75.00, and a waiting list for spaces is maintained by the Harbormaster.
3. The fee for small-boat trailer parking is \$25.
4. The annual fee for club boat usages (including the RL, the Skipjacks, the Laser and Flying Junior) is \$75.00

## **Work Party Credit**

This club and community exist and thrive through the voluntary contributions of its members. We discourage people from joining who do not feel they want to invest their time in the ASC. In order to have a functioning facility and a healthy club we need to contribute some time and effort. Working members participate in a full day Fall and Spring work party (there are two of each) or provide the ASC with other important services or arrange with a committee chairperson or board member to work on a specific project. There are many jobs that do not require physical strength or special skills. In recognition of this effort the ASC offers a \$50 membership credit if you attended at least two work parties the previous year.

# 2010 Rules of the Alaska Sailing Club:



These rules have been developed by the club to avoid conflict, insure safety and promote a positive community here at the Alaska Sailing Club. Thank you for reading these carefully and following them.

1. *Driving on the club site:* We ask that people drive slowly, use caution and good judgment when driving on club property. This is for the safety of children, pets and others. Parking is available behind the club house and along the drive ways as well as in the public parking lot by the boat launch. Traffic on the waterfront (between the sauna and hoist) is restricted due to safety concerns. For unloading on the waterfront please inform the other members present of your intentions so they may move their children and belongings out of the way.
2. *Facilities usage:* Use of dock facilities limited to sailboats and muscle powered crafts. Personal Watercraft (Jetskis, Waverunners, etc.) are prohibited from the club site. Member owned motorized craft, other than PWC, may be authorized for use of two marked transient berths on B dock. Any motorized craft berthed must be available for club usage as an emergency rescue boat, should the need arise.
3. *Life jackets:* Life jackets must be worn on all boats at all times. Life jackets are required to be worn on all children and non-swimmers while on the docks.
4. *Registration:* All boats and trailers using the facility must be registered with the harbormaster for moorage, dock and land parking assignments. A list will be kept in the clubhouse.
5. *Parking:* Waterfront area between the lift and sauna building must be kept clear of boats, cars, trailers, campers, etc. to allow easy access to the docks and viewing of the lake.
6. *Boat trailers:* Should be parked at the top of the hill across from the outhouses.
7. *Tents:* See site map with designated areas or ask a board member for assistance.
8. *Garbage:* Haul out what you haul in. During potlucks we recycle cans, glass and plastic as well as garbage. Members willing to take garbage and recycling materials are always welcome.
9. *Firewood:* Replace firewood you use in the clubhouse with wood from outside. We welcome more firewood or sources of firewood. There is a limited supply of wood for the club house, sauna and campfires. Please be considerate and conservative with your use of wood. Club trees are not be logged without permission from the Landscape Committee.
10. *Helping out:* When you see something that needs to be done please help the club by correcting the problem or letting someone know there is a problem. That's how we work together to make our boats and facilities safe and fun.
11. *Maintaining the club:* Volunteering time at work parties or on other projects is encouraged. The work of maintaining our club needs to be completed by the membership of it just won't get done. Members that participate in the spring work party or the fall work party will be given a \$50 deduction on the next year's dues. If you are unable to attend the work parties, an equivalent level of volunteering at other times will be considered adequate. For further information see ASC volunteer opportunities list.

12. *Overnighters*: Overnight docking is welcome while members are present on the club site. Please, secure club boats carefully to insure that the hull and sail are not damaged by rubbing on the dock and other boats. If in doubt ask for advice from other members.
13. *Membership renewal*: If membership is not renewed in any given year, and there is property stored at the club site by the non-renewing member, the member agrees to pay a storage fee of \$10.00 per day, and further agrees that the Alaska Sailing Club may make such use of the property as it deems appropriate.
14. *Dogs and pets*: Dog and pet owners are asked to be considerate of other club members by: supervising their pets carefully, being diligent about cleaning up any feces that they see (orange bags are provided at the club house and sauna), and to confine their pets while members are dining and during potlucks. Having your pet at the club is a privilege. Owners are requested to kennel their animals that are behaving unsafely or become a nuisance at the club. Members are welcome to bring their animals; visitors are kindly asked to keep their pets on leash, in a kennel, or at home. We love our pets and we need to be considerate and clean.
15. *Guests*: The club is a wonderful place to entertain our family and friends. Guests are welcome. The sponsoring host must be onsite at the club when their guests are present. As the hosting member you are responsible to be sure that your family and friends follow the rules and respect the club properties and members. The sponsoring host is required to obtain a signed a liability form from their guests. They must also sign that they have read and understand the club rules. Boats are for the use of our members. Guests are welcome to be on the boats with their host.

# Release of Liability Agreement

I, \_\_\_\_\_, am aware that water sports (including sailboat racing) are hazardous activities. I wish to participate and / or receive instruction in these activities with the Alaska Sailing Club, Inc. (ASC). I have full knowledge of the dangers involved, and agree to accept any and all risks of injuries or death that may occur.

\_\_\_\_\_ (initial that you have read this paragraph)

*Giving Up My Legal Rights.* By signing this agreement I agree to give up for myself and for my heirs, certain legal rights which I may have in the event I become injured or killed while participating or receiving instruction in water sports with ASC or while utilizing ASC property. I am giving up my legal rights against ASC and my fellow participants in ASC activities. As used in this agreement the ASC shall mean Alaska Sailing Club, Inc. and all of its leaders instructors, officers and directors.

\_\_\_\_\_ (initial that you have read this paragraph)

*My Promise Not To Sue.* I agree that I will not sue or otherwise make any claim against ASC or my fellow participants in ASC activities for injury, death or damage to me or my property which occurs in the course of my participation or instruction in water sports or my utilization of ASC property.

\_\_\_\_\_ (initial that you have read this paragraph)

*My Release of Liability.* I also agree to release and discharge ASC and my fellow participants in ASC activities from all actions, claims or demands both for myself and for my heirs, dependents, and/or personal representatives, for injuries, death or damage to me in the course of my participation or instruction in water sports or my utilization of ASC property.

\_\_\_\_\_ (initial that you have read this paragraph)

*My Promise to Indemnify.* I agree to pay all costs and expenses, including attorney's fees and court costs, that ASC may incur as a consequence of any legal action arising out of injury, death or damage to me or to someone else as a result of my conduct.

\_\_\_\_\_ (initial that you have read this paragraph)

*My Consent to Medical Treatment.* I consent to any hospital care or medical or surgical diagnosis or treatment which may be necessary as a result of my participation in activities with ASC. I also understand and agree I am solely responsible for all applicable charges for such medical treatment, including evacuation and/or rescue cost.

I understand that the ASC requires that I execute this Agreement as a condition of participating in water sports with ASC.

I also understand that all the terms of this agreement are binding upon me, my relatives, heirs, dependents, and/or personal representatives. I HAVE CAREFULLY READ THIS AGREEMENT AND FULLY UNDERSTAND ITS CONTENTS. I AM AWARE THAT THIS IS A BINDING, LEGAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN ME AND ASC AND I SIGN IT OF MY OWN FREE WILL.
